CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the above-entitled action before the Securities Commissioner of Kansas for further consideration. Upon due deliberation, the Commissioner finds as follows:

1. Respondent David M. Hulshof, d/b/a Buena Vista Business Services, L.L.C., and staff for the Office of the Securities Commissioner have entered into a Stipulation for Consent Order in this matter.
2. In the above-referenced Stipulation, Respondent has waived his right to a hearing to contest the allegations set forth in the Stipulation. Therefore, this Order may be issued without further proceedings.
3. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations contained in the Stipulation for Consent Order.
4. It is in the public interest and consistent with purposes of the Kansas Securities Act and the Kansas Uniform Securities Act that this Order be issued.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Fact set forth in the Stipulation for Consent Order as true and correct findings of fact, and the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Law as true and correct conclusions of law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Securities Commissioner of Kansas that Respondent David M. Hulshof, d/b/a Buena Vista Business Services, L.L.C., and any person in concert or participation with him who receives actual notice of this Order, shall immediately CEASE AND DESIST in the State of Kansas from all acts and practices which constitute violations of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Securities Commissioner of Kansas that:

- (a) Respondent DISGORGE the commission received, in the amount of \$5,067.00, to [REDACTED];
- (b) Respondent pay a FINE to the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner in the amount of \$1,500.00; and
- (c) Respondent will pay said disgorgement and fine as follows: (i) \$3,500.00 on the date of signing of the Stipulation for Consent Order; and (ii) the remaining \$3,067.00 on or before January 15, 2010.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
