CONSENT ORDER FOR RESPONDENTS PROFESSIONAL  
INVESTMENT SERVICES, INC., AND DON H. EHLING

COMES NOW the above entitled action before the Securities Commissioner of Kansas for further consideration. Upon due deliberation, the Commissioner finds as follows:

1. The Securities Commissioner has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this action.
2. Respondents Don H. Ehling and Professional Investment Services, Inc., have entered into a Stipulation for Consent Order with staff for the Office of the Securities Commissioner.
3. In the Stipulation for Consent Order, Respondents Don H. Ehling and Professional Investment Services, Inc., waived their rights to any hearing to contest the allegations set forth in the Notice of Intent to Impose Sanctions Under the Kansas Uniform Securities Act issued in this matter on June 29, 2009. Without admitting or denying the allegations, the Respondents consented to the entry of this Order. The Respondents also waived the right to seek judicial review of this proceeding.
4. It is in the public interest and consistent with the purposes of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act that this order be issued.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Fact set forth in the Notice of Intent as true and correct findings of fact, and the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Law set forth in the Notice of Intent as true and correct conclusions of law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Respondents Don H. Ehling and Professional Investment Services, Inc., are hereby CENSURED by the Securities Commissioner of Kansas.
