**THE FOLLOWING ORDER APPLIES TO RESPONDENTS
INTER REEF LTD. d/b/a PROFITABLE SUNRISE,
ROMAN NOVAK, and RADOSLAV NOVAK ONLY**

FINAL ORDER IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTIONS

COMES NOW the above-entitled matter for consideration by the Securities
Commissioner of Kansas. Upon due deliberation, the Commissioner finds as follows:

Findings of Fact

1. On April 24, 2013, the Securities Commissioner of Kansas issued a Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions against the above named respondents.
2. A copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions issued in this matter was sent on April 29, 2013, via FedEx International, to Respondent Inter Reef Ltd. d/b/a Profitable Sunrise (Profitable Sunrise) at its last known business address of 590A Kingsbury Road, Birmingham, United Kingdom, B249ND.

3. The copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was sent to Respondent Profitable Sunrise was delivered by FedEx International on May 2, 2013, and signed for by O. Okeefe.

4. A copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions issued in this matter was sent on April 29, 2013, via FedEx International, to Respondent Roman Novak at his last known business address of 590A Kingsbury Road, Birmingham, United Kingdom, B249ND.

5. The copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was sent to Respondent Roman Novak was delivered by FedEx International on May 1, 2013, and signed for by M. Murray.

6. A copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions issued in this matter was sent on April 29, 2013, via FedEx International, to Respondent Radoslav Novak at his last known business address of 590A Kingsbury Road, Birmingham, United Kingdom, B249ND.

7. The copy of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was sent to Respondent Radoslav Novak was delivered by FedEx International on May 1, 2013, and signed for by M. Murray.

8. As of the date of this order, Respondent Profitable Sunrise has not requested a hearing in this matter.

9. As of the date of this order, Respondent Roman Novak has not requested a hearing in this matter.

10. As of the date of this order, Respondent Radoslav Novak has not requested a hearing in this matter.

11. Respondent Profitable Sunrise did not request a hearing within 30 days of service of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was issue in this matter.

12. Respondent Roman Novak did not request a hearing within 30 days of service of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was issue in this matter.

13. Respondent Radoslav Novak did not request a hearing within 30 days of service of the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was issue in this matter.

14. Staff for the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner has filed a motion in this matter for the issuance of a final order imposing administrative sanctions.

15. The Findings of Fact listed in the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was issued in this matter on April 24, 2013, are hereby incorporated into this order as if fully set forth herein.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Securities Commissioner of Kansas has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. The Cease and Desist Order issued in this matter on April 24, 2013, is a final order as to Respondents Inter Reef Ltd. d/b/a Profitable Sunrise, Roman Novak, and Radoslav Novak due to failure to request a hearing in a timely manner, pursuant to K.S.A. 17-12a604(c)(2).
3. The Securities Commissioner of Kansas may immediately impose administrative sanctions against Respondents Inter Reef Ltd. d/b/a Profitable Sunrise, Roman Novak, and

Radoslav Novak due to failure to request a hearing in a timely manner, pursuant to K.S.A. 17-12a604(c)(3).


4. The Conclusions of Law listed in the Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Impose Administrative Sanctions that was issue in this matter on April 24, 2013, are hereby incorporated into this order as if fully set forth herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Securities Commissioner that:

1. Respondent Inter Reef Ltd. d/b/a Profitable Sunrise shall pay a civil penalty of \$25,000.
2. Respondent Roman Novak shall pay a civil penalty of \$25,000.
3. Respondent Radoslav Novak shall pay a civil penalty of \$25,000.
4. The civil penalties ordered herein shall be paid by the Respondents, within 30 days from the issuance of this order, in the form of cashier's checks or money orders made payable to the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner and shall be delivered to the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner located at 109 SW 9th Street, Suite 600, Topeka, Kansas 66612.
