CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the above-entitled action before the Securities Commissioner of Kansas for further consideration. Upon due deliberation, the Commissioner finds as follows:

1. Respondents Michael Edwin Betzel, Guardian Knight Security and staff for the Office of the Securities Commissioner have entered into a Stipulation for Consent Order in this matter.

2. In the above-referenced Stipulation, Respondents have waived their rights to a hearing to contest the allegations set forth in the Stipulation. Therefore, this Order may be issued without further proceedings.

3. It is in the public interest and consistent with purposes of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act that this Order be issued.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioner adopts the stipulations in the Stipulation for Consent Order as true and correct findings of fact and law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Securities Commissioner of Kansas that Respondent Michael Edwin Betzel is hereby BARRED from association with any broker-

dealer, agent, investment adviser or investment adviser representative registered in the State of Kansas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Michael Edwin Betzel is ORDERED to Cease and Desist from selling unregistered securities in the State of Kansas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Guardian Knight Security is hereby ORDERED to Cease and Desist from employing or associating with an unregistered agent in the State of Kansas.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
