STIPULATION FOR CONSENT ORDER

This proceeding follows an investigation conducted by the Office of the Securities Commissioner of Kansas. As a result of this investigation, staff of the Office of the Securities Commissioner of Kansas makes the following allegations.

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

1. Respondent The Wright Legacy Group, LLC (CRD# 146934) (“WLG”), is a Kentucky state registered investment advisor, not currently registered in the State of Kansas to offer investment advice. Respondent WLG has a business address of 1104 Julianna Court, Elizabethtown, KY 42702.
2. Respondent Bill S. Meador (CRD# 4637691) (“Meador”) is a representative of WLG and has a business address of 5959 Outlook St. #5, Mission, KS 66202.
3. Beginning in April 2010, Respondent Meador, as an investment advisor representative of Respondent WLG began providing investment advisory services to clients from his Kansas office. Respondent Meador managed client accounts that were held at TD Ameritrade.

4. Billings for the investment advisory services were issued by Respondent WLG. Respondent WLG retained one-third of all fees generated by Respondent Meador and paid the rest to Respondent Meador.
5. At no time from April 2010, until the date of this Stipulation for Consent Order, were either Respondent WLG or Respondent Meador registered with the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner as either an investment advisor or investment advisor representative.

ALLEGATIONS OF LAW

6. Respondent WLG transacted business in Kansas as an investment advisor without registration with the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner in violation of K.S.A. 17-12a403.
7. Respondent Meador transacted business in Kansas as an investment advisor representative without registration with the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner in violation of K.S.A. 17-12a404.

Respondents WLG and Meador, wishing to obtain a disposition of the above referenced matter without invoking their right to a hearing, have determined not to contest the issuance of the attached Consent Order based on the above referenced allegations.

IT IS, THEREFORE, STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Respondents WLG and Meador and the staff of the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner that:

1. The attached Consent Order may be issued by the Securities Commissioner of Kansas without further proceedings.
2. The attached Consent Order shall constitute neither an admission nor a denial that the allegations serving as a basis for the Consent Order are true.

3. Respondents WLG and Meador waive their rights to any hearing prior to the issuance of the attached Consent Order on the basis of the allegations herein contained.
4. Respondent WLG shall make a contribution in the amount of \$1,500 to the Investor Education Fund authorized by K.S.A. 17-12a601(d)(2).
5. Respondent Meador shall make a contribution in the amount of \$750 to the Investor Education Fund authorized by K.S.A. 17-12a601(d)(2).
6. Respondent WLG shall pay a fine to the Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner in the amount of \$2,500.
7. Respondents shall submit all payments with the executed stipulation and shall be by certified check, money order or check drawn on counsel's attorney trust account.
