**STATE'S MOTION FOR DEFAULT ORDER OF SANCTIONS AGAINST
RESPONDENTS EASTRIDGE GROUP INC., AND BRIAN EASTRIDGE**

COMES NOW the State of Kansas, by and through Erin M. Hoestje, Associate General Counsel, Office of the Kansas Securities Commissioner, and moves that the Commissioner issue a Default Order against Respondents Eastridge Group Inc., and Brian Eastridge.

IN SUPPORT OF SAID MOTION, Movant states the following:

1. That a Notice of Intent to Invoke Administrative Sanctions was duly executed in Topeka, Kansas on September 30, 2010, and mailed on September 30, 2010, by certified mail, return receipt requested. On October 1, 2010, Respondent Eastridge Group was served with the certified mail and was signed by David Quillen. The Notice of Intent issued to Brian Eastridge was returned as unclaimed.

2. The Notice of Intent was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested. again on October 14, 2010, to the same address as the Eastridge Group. It was returned as unclaimed.
3. The Notice of Intent was mailed by first class mail on October 26, 2010 to Brian Eastridge. It was not returned.
4. Respondents were required to file a Request for Hearing on or before November 30, 2010, that date being thirty-three (33) days after the date of mailing on the Certificate of Service of the Notice of Intent, pursuant to K.A.R. 81-11-5 and K.S.A 77-531.
5. Respondents Eastridge Group, Inc., and Brian Eastridge have filed no request for hearing at the time this motion was filed.

WHEREFORE, the Movant prays that the Commissioner finds that the allegations set forth in the Notice of Intent are admitted by the Respondents. The Movant further prays that the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Fact as true and correct findings of fact, and the Commissioner adopts the Allegations of Law as conclusions of law.

The Movant prays that upon consideration of the reasons set forth in the Notice of Intent, and after due deliberation, the Commissioner will find that it is in the public interest and consistent with the purposes of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act to issue a Default Order of Sanctions, including the following sanctions, or any other such relief the Commissioner deems just and equitable.

The Movant prays that the Commissioner orders the following sanctions against the Respondent:

1. A permanent order to cease and desist from (1) transacting business in the State of Kansas as broker-dealers or agents, as defined in K.S.A. 17-1252 and K.S.A. 17-12a102, unless the persons engaged in such business are registered under the Kansas Uniform Securities Act or exempt from registration; (2) employing or associating with any agent transacting business in the State of Kansas unless the agent is registered under the Kansas Uniform Securities Act; (3) offering or selling any security in the State of Kansas unless the security is registered under the Kansas Uniform Securities Act or exempt from registration; and (4) engaging in any other acts or practices which constitute violations of the Kansas Uniform Securities Act;
2. A bar from association with any broker-dealer or investment adviser registered in this state.
3. A denial of registration of Respondent's applications to become a Registered Investment Adviser and Registered Investment Adviser Representative.
4. An order to pay restitution in the amount of \$128,817.22 to the Kansas residents mentioned in the Notice of Intent.
